Description of each Scholarship

Marilyn Lawrenz Memorial Scholarship- Marilyn Lawrenz was a school teacher in the Wellsville School District. Upon her passing her family and friends made a gift to the Wellsville United Methodist church on Sept 7, 1994 to establish a scholarship fund in her name. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to eligible individuals for educational scholarships for college attendance and/or institute scholarships for the attendance at The United Methodist Church Institute in Baldwin City, Kansas. For the educational scholarship, Each Eligible Individual must be an active member of the Wellsville United Methodist Church, must be either a graduating high school senior or a full time undergraduate college student enrolled in at least 12 semester hours. Must be enrolled to attend a college, or university or post-secondary vocational or technical school pursuing an associate or bachelor degree, or its equivalent and must actually be accepted as a full time student. Descendants of (a) Marilyn Lawrenz and (b) the scholarship committee members are not eligible individuals. The scholarship committee will make their selection based upon academic performance, past and future church and community involvement, special financial circumstances and a statement of faith. The decision of the scholarship committee in selecting the scholarship recipients shall be binding to all interested parties.

Jennie Lytle Memorial Scholarship- Jennie Lytle was the Librarian at the Wellsville City Library. Upon her passing her family made a gift to the Wellsville United Methodist Church to establish a scholarship fund in her name. The purpose of this scholarship is to provide financial assistance to eligible individuals for educational scholarships for college attendance and/or institute scholarships for the attendance at The United Methodist Church Institute in Baldwin City, Kansas and other United Methodist camps and activities. For the educational scholarship, Each Eligible Individual must be an active member of the Wellsville United Methodist Church, must be either a graduating high school senior or a full time undergraduate college student enrolled in at least 12 semester hours. Must be enrolled to attend a college, or university or post-secondary vocational or technical school pursuing an associate or bachelor degree, or its equivalent and must actually be accepted as a full time student. The scholarship committee will make their selection based upon academic performance, past and future church and community involvement, special financial circumstances and a statement of faith. The decision of the scholarship committee in selecting the scholarship recipients shall be binding to all interested parties.

Marion and Avis McConnell Memorial Scholarship in honor of Norman McConnell - Marion and Avis McConnell were residents of Wellsville and their son attended Wellsville School. He was killed in an accident before he could graduate. Upon their passing they made a gift to the Wellsville United Methodist Church to establish a scholarship in his honor. The purpose of the Scholarship fund shall be to provide financial assistance to eligible individuals in the form of educational scholarships for college attendance and/or trade schools. Each eligible individual must be a member or a descendent of a member of the Wellsville United Methodist Church and be a graduate of Wellsville High School. Each eligible individual must be enrolled to attend a college, or university, or a post-secondary, vocational, technical or trade school pursuing a degree or an equivalent, and must actually be accepted as a student by such an institution in order to receive the award. The scholarship committee will make their selection based upon academic performance, past and future church and community involvement, special financial circumstances and a statement of faith. The decision of the scholarship committee in selecting the scholarship recipients shall be binding to all interested parties.
